Youth Ministry Insight CONNECTING (IN)

"A universal essential of the Society of Christian Endeavor is fidelity to its own church and the work of that church. It does not and cannot exist for itself."

We value youth connecting IN healthy life-giving relationships with Christ and His Church. Loyalty to Christ and the local church are interconnected. It's in the soil of Christian community that youth mature into Christ's likeness (Eph. 4:11-13). A Christian Endeavor group (society) should be closely connected to its church family.

Thus, a biblically sound youth ministry will foster unity among young and old as all worship, fellowship, and minister alongside each other. It's in this spirit of connectedness that the Spirit adds saved souls to the Church (Acts 2:42-47). When youth are planted in the life and community of the church, and rooted in Scripture, they grow.

Practical Steps

1. Consider ways that young people are already engaged in the work and worship of the larger church. Take time to intentionally celebrate this!
2. Identify one new way that young people can connect in to the larger church body. Intentionally implement this in the next month.
3. Form a prayer team with the intentional focus of praying for connection and unity across all generations in your church family.
